We installed a new trash screen at the head end of the E67 canal that backed water up a bit and messed with our flow readings, so we had to make adjustments for that canal. The correct number to use for the E67 Canal diversions is in the IRREFNCY spreadsheet. For the Phelps and E65 canals, The IRREFNCY spreadsheet shows the amount of the water diverted during the irrigation season only. The Central System Data spreadsheet shows irrigation diversions as well as recharge diversions. Does that answer your question?
